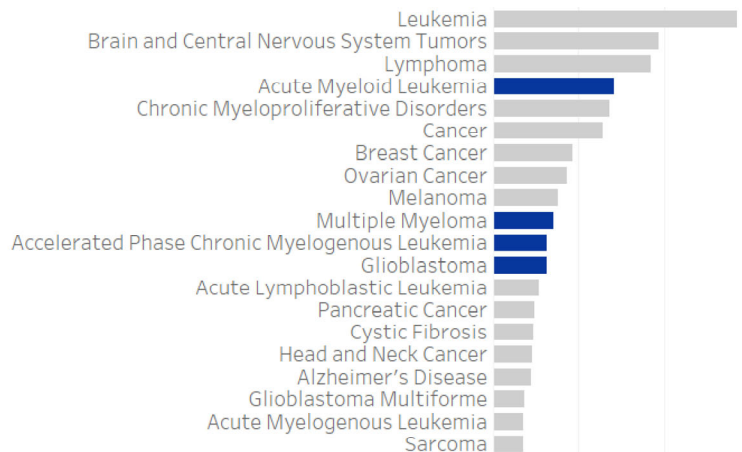


Public vs Private Funding And It's Impact On Clinical Trials

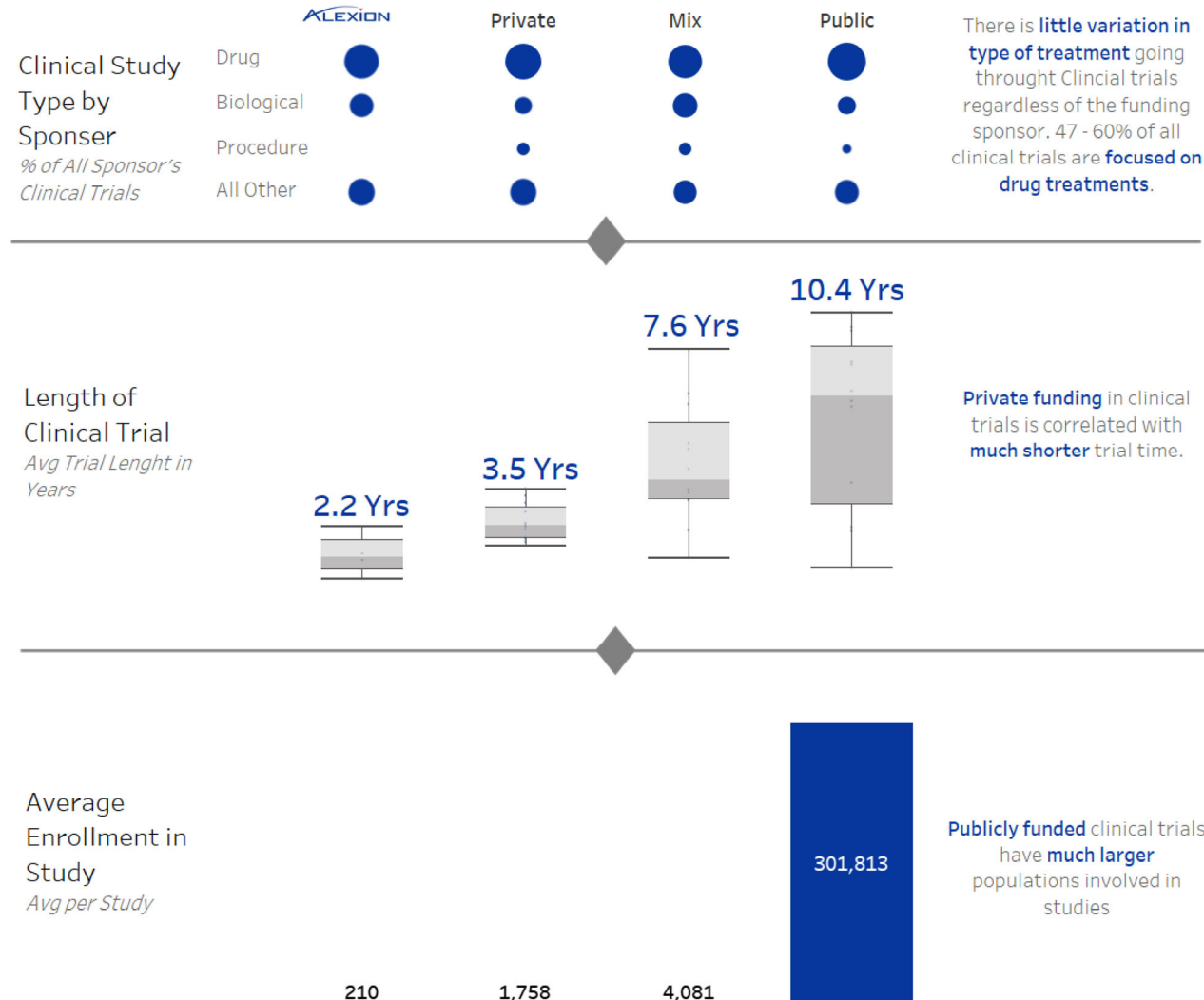
Clinical trials with private sponsorship are **shorter** and more **targeted** in scope than those with public sponsorship

Of the top 20 conditions undergoing clinical trials only four are rare diseases



Both rare and more common diseases have the same mix of sponsors, but rare diseases are more likely to be exclusively funded by a private sponsor.

Share of Clinical Studies	Private	Mix	Public	Total
All top 20 Conditions	56%	38%	6%	100%
Rare Conditions Only	75%	17%	7%	100%
